# How is P3N building our ACO?

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- In 2016 the National Association of ACO's reported the average cost of an ACO like ours to be **\$1.9 million** in the first year.
- As a result, the federal government encouraged financial support of ACO's from healthcare companies (waiver participants).
- Waiver Participants contribute their financial resources explicitly to develop and support the programs that meet the CMS objective of better care for the patient.
